## ROBERT MILTON BISHOP

*A 1943 graduate of Union College in Schenectady, New York, Robert Bishop entered the USAAF as an aviation cadet and earned his commission and his wings with Class 44-F at Columbus Field, Mississippi. He was assigned as a multi-engine instructor pilot in the Eastern Flying Training Command. He was in a Douglas B-26 transition unit, preparing for deployment to the Pacific Theater of Operations, when the war ended. Leadership and responsibility as a cadet officer, instructor pilot, and base operations officer -- these were the first steps that led to a career in management and finance. He retired in 1976 as Senior Vice President of the New York Stock Exchange.*
