Whit Beardsley served as a Protestant Chaplain in the 3rd Photo Reconnaissance Group, XIIth Air Force and participated in the North African, Sicilian and Italian Campaigns during World War II. Discharged in 1945, he was later recalled for the Korean War and served until 1952. He then served in the United States Air Force Reserve until May 1972. When not on active duty, Whit served churches in Massachusetts, Illinois, Connecticut, California, Rhode Island and Colorado. He was a man of God, a beloved husband and Father.
