Arthur H. Rogers was born December 27, 1911 in Beckley, West Virginia. He graduated from North Carolina State College in 1933 and received his pilot's wings in 1935. He served in the 2nd Bomb Group and the 25th Bomb Group before being assigned to the 90th Bomb Group that was activated in April 1942. He became commanding officer of the 90th in 1943 and was retired in 1947 because of disability. His decorations include the Distinguished Service Cross, Silver Star, Distinguished Flying Cross, Air Medal, Bronze Star, Legion of Merit and Commendation Medal.
