Horace (Ho) Levy enlisted in the U. S. Army Cavalry Reserve October 13, 1939 and became a 2nd Lieutenant on January 4, 1941. He was called to active duty February 10, 1941 and rose to the rank of Lt. Colonel in 1954. He flew in WWII, Korea and Vietnam. He was awarded the Bronze Star for Meritorious Service with one Oak Leaf Cluster, Air Force Commendation Medal with two Oak Leaf Clusters, the Presidential Unit Citation, Asiatic Pacific Campaign Medal with four stars and one arrow and many others. He received a disability retirement from the United States Air Force in the grade of Lt. Colonel after 29 years of service. He was an original Trustee of the 5th Air Force Memorial Foundation.
