David Hollenbaugh was born in Tiffin, Ohio, on August 15, 1929. He entered the U.S. Air Force as a pilot trainee in 1951 and served as a pilot for many years including service in the Strategic Air Command. He served overseas in Japan, England, Guam and Okinawa, and as a commander and staff officer in various stateside assignments. He was awarded the Air Force Air Medal and the Department of Defense and Air Force Meritorious Service Medals. He was also awarded the National Aeronautical Associations Medal of Honor for saving the life of a small boy alone in a run-away hot air balloon. He was married to Virginia Guhin for forty years and they raised two children: a daughter, Mary Schwartz; and a son, Michael.
