Educated in Alabama and Florida public schools, Lt. Colonel Hargrove enlisted in the Army Air Corps in 1942. Progressively promoted through the enlisted and warrant officer grades, he received a direct commission as captain in the United States Air Force in 1951. He served with distinction at all levels of command, in all parts of the world, and in 1962, was awarded the Legion of Merit by the Secretary of the Air Force. After his retirement from active duty, he held positions of significant responsibility with the Air Academy National Bank, retiring as Executive Vice President in 1987.
