A B-17 pilot shot down 1 May 1943 over Brest, France and a Prisoner of War in Stalag Luft III for 24 months, he later had a distinguished, thirty-year career as a writer and military correspondent for the Detroit News. He flew missions in Korea and Vietnam and covered space operations at Cape Canaveral. Among his many distinctions are his having flown over 25 different military aircraft and having been inducted into the Michigan Aviation Hall of Fame.
