Lieutenant Colonel Graham was a Bombardier with the 306th Group. On 9 November 1942 his B-17 was downed by flak over St. Nazaire, France. Andy was captured and taken to Stalag Luft III in Germany. He remained there until January 1945 when the POWs were moved to Moosburg in Bavaria. He was liberated on 29 April 1945. He earned the highest respect and friendship of his fellow Kriegies for his outstanding selflessness, decency, and unfailing consideration of others. Colonel Graham died in Pulaski, Virginia on 5 March 2002.
