As a Lieutenant, Richard Toler was a U. S. Army Air Corps Pilot stationed at Hickam Field, Hawaii. During the 7 December 1941 Japanese raid on the Island of Oahu, he was assigned to the 42nd Bomb Squadron. He was the co-pilot on the Commander's B-17 aircraft. He subsequently participated in the battle for Midway Island. When the 42nd transferred to the Solomon Islands, he participated in the battle for Guadalcanal. He remained in the service after the war ended and retired as a Lt. Colonel.
