*John entered the Academy from Pasadena, California with the Class of 1960, first in CS-3 then CS-12 at graduation. John became a pilot and flew F-100s during the early part of his career. He completed 187 combat missions in Viet Nam before returning to obtain an advanced degree from UCLA. He then returned to the Academy in 1970 to instruct Political Science achieving Associate Professorship in 1972. He then returned to UCLA, where he earned his PhD, following which he spent most of the remainder of his working career in the academic world, initially at the Academy and ultimately as Scholar in Residence at American University in 1994. John maintained that position until his death.*
