1937-2002

George entered the Air Force Academy with the Class of 1960 after spending a year at Providence College. At USAFA George was an accomplished fencer, Editor-in-chief of the "Dodo", and a squadron commander. Following graduation he was a KC-97 navigator for four years. He then earned an advanced degree from Syracuse University and returned to the Academy as an instructor in the Psychology Department. In 1966 the Superintendent selected George to be the second Executive Secretary of the Association of Graduates. George resigned from the Air Force in 1970. Ultimately his travels took him to New Zealand where he established the School of Business at Massey University. He served in various higher education positions in the South Pacific area until his death.
