ROBERT MERILL LEE, GENERAL, US AIR FORCE

General Lee, born in New Hampshire in 1909 and reared in Maine, graduated from West Point in 1931. He served as an Aide, flew the mail, and attended the Air Corps Tactical School. In 1944 Colonel Lee was with the 9th Air Force in four major campaigns in France. With distinction he also served in Korea and Germany. He retired as full General in 1966 after serving as Air Deputy to the Supreme Allied Commander in Europe. Lee was highly decorated for service to his nation and several foreign countries. He married Julia N. Ball in 1932, (deceased 1937); Mary Hall VanPelt in 1940, (deceased 1973); and Mary Frances Donnellan, who resides in Florida, in 1974. General Lee, who died in 2003, was a distinguished airman, commander, and a devoted husband and father.
