Captain Dedmon served in the U. S. Army Air Corps and U. S. Army Air Forces from 1940 to 1945. As a navigator in the 327th Bomb Squadron, 92nd Bomb Group, he flew to England in August 1942. He was the Navigation Staff Officer, 8th Bomber Command from January to June 1943 when he was shot down over Germany and became a POW until 1945. He was awarded the Air Medal, ETO medal with two bronze stars, American Defense Medal, and the Victory medal.
