Sergeant Dolph was a gunner on a B-24 of the 466th Bomb Group which was shot down over Vechta, Germany on 15 August 1944. He parachuted into Holland and evaded capture for eight months in the Dutch underground until his return to Allied control on 15 April 1945. He subsequently became the Director of the Air Force Escape and Evasion Society. He wrote "The Evader", a narrative of his wartime experience which was published in 1991.
