Colonel Kelly had a distinguished military career serving 31 years in the U.S. Army as a Combat Veteran in World War II, Korea, and the Vietnam War. His expertise in counterinsurgency warfare led to his appointment to a key role in developing the Army's Special Forces (Green Berets). During the 1960s, he commanded the First and Fifth Special Forces. He was one of the most decorated colonels of the Vietnam War and was regarded as one of the top guerrilla fighters in the world.
