HENRY W. SUPCHAK

Henry Supchak was the pilot of a B-17 named "Lucky Lady" in the 91st Squadron of the 323rd Bomb Group, 8th Air Force operating out of England in 1944. On July 31, 1944, on his 33rd combat mission he was shot down over Munich and, along with his crew, became a prisoner of war at Stalag Luft III. He was awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross, the Air Medal with five Oak Leaf Clusters and the Purple Heart.
