FIRST LIEUTENANT, U. S. AIR FORCE RESERVE

Bob Weinberg was born in Chicago February 19, 1922. He grew up in Highland Park and studied at the University of North Carolina. He left school and enlisted in the Air Corps in April 1942 and graduated from flying school as a navigator in early 1944. He went to the Mediterranean Theater and flew 38 missions in B-24s of the 434th Bomb Group. He was shot down and captured August 24, 1944 and was a POW until April 29, 1945. After the war he made a career in the hotel supply business and married Nina D'Ancona December 22, 1945. They raised three sons. Bob was the first and only president of the Stalag Luft III Former POWs serving with distinction from January 1982 until the Association ceased operation May 31, 1997. Bob and Nina were universally admired and respected for their devoted work for the Association.
