"Chuck" Lipsky was assigned to the 97th Heavy Bomb Group after graduating from flying school in Class 41I and proceeded with it to England in the summer of 1942. As a lead pilot in the 340th Squadron, he flew combat missions until his aircraft was shot down on a mission to destroy an aircraft factory at Alberta, France, on September 6, 1942. He and his entire crew survived and became POWs of the Germans until the end of the war. During the more than two years he spent as a POW, he continued to display his practical common-sense commitment to our service goals and standards and earned the highest respect and warmest regards of his fellow prisoners as an officer and friend.
