General Lyle was initially commissioned in 1938 in Arkansas. Following pilot training in 1941 he served in England where he completed more than seventy missions with the 8th and the 15th Air Forces and became commander of the 41st Combat Wing. Post World War II assignments were primarily with the Strategic Air Command from which he retired in 1967. He was instrumental in establishing the Mighty Eighth Air Force Heritage Museum. General Lyle's awards include the Distinguished Service Cross, the Distinguished Service Medal, the Silver Star with two clusters and the Distinguished Flying Cross.
