"Nick" Nichols, a graduate of Princeton, was commissioned in the Field Artillery Reserve. After flight training, he served in the Army Air Corps in New York. At the outbreak of World War II he was Deputy Commander, Clark Field, the Philippines. After further assignments in New York and South and Central America, he retired after forty years service. Admiral Richard Byrd sponsored Colonel Nichols' induction into the "Quiet Birdman," an organization of flyers started by Charles Lindbergh.
