William "Bill" Madsen volunteered for the Civil Air Patrol in 1941 and served until his death on June 23, 1998. Achieving the rank of colonel, he faithfully served the interests of the Nation, the U.S. Air Force and the Air Force Academy for 57 years. A private pilot, he soloed in 1942 and completed some 5,000 hours of flying time. As President of the Colorado Aviation Society and a member of the Silver Wings and numerous other organizations, he was inducted into the Colorado Aviation Hall of Fame. He was highly respected and admired by all of his colleagues.
