Colonel Richard L. Davis was commissioned into the Army Air Corps in 1945, served as a bomber pilot during World War II and flew in the Berlin Airlift. He was assigned to the Pentagon then to Headquarters Strategic Air Command, Offutt Air Force Base, Nebraska; Headquarters, 7th Air Division, RAF High Wycombe, United Kingdom; and to the Air Force Military Personnel Center, Randolph Air Force Base, Texas. Colonel Davis retired from active duty in 1971 after having last served as Deputy Chief of Staff, Personnel, at the United States Air Force Academy. His military decorations include the Legion of Merit, the Air Force Commendation Medal with two Oak Leaf Clusters, the American Campaign Medal, the World War II Victory Medal, and the Army of Occupation Medal (Germany) with Berlin Airlift Device.
