Jack Mohn graduated from the University of Pennsylvania on the eve of the Korean War. He served in the United States Air Force from August 1950 to July 1954 at Lackland Air Force Base, Texas; Fort Sam Houston, Texas; Lowry Air Force Base, Colorado; and Gunter Air Force Base, Alabama. He served as a Medical Services supervisor and instructor at the Medical Field Service School, attaining the rank of staff sergeant and training many of the Air Force medics who served in Korea. After his discharge, he began a thirty-six-year career teaching American history, world geography, and Western civilization in the school district serving Scotch Plains and Fanwood, New Jersey. He was an inspiring teacher who imparted both knowledge of the world and love of country.
